The system is certified for clearing manifests through CBP in all U.S. ports and is compliant with the Advanced Security Filing (SF-5) and Stow Plan requirements of the 10+2 Rule. System Features:

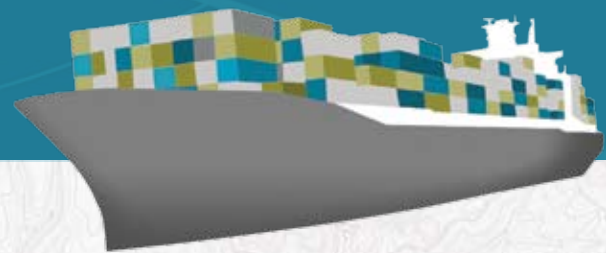
- » Streamlines manifest submissions through user-friendly data entry and import interface

Notice of Arrival & Departure (NOA/D) On-Line

- » Immediate responses from U.S. Coast Guard of receipt of NOA/D
- » Copy data feature to streamline updates, notices of departure, filings at subsequent U.S. port calls and repeat voyages
